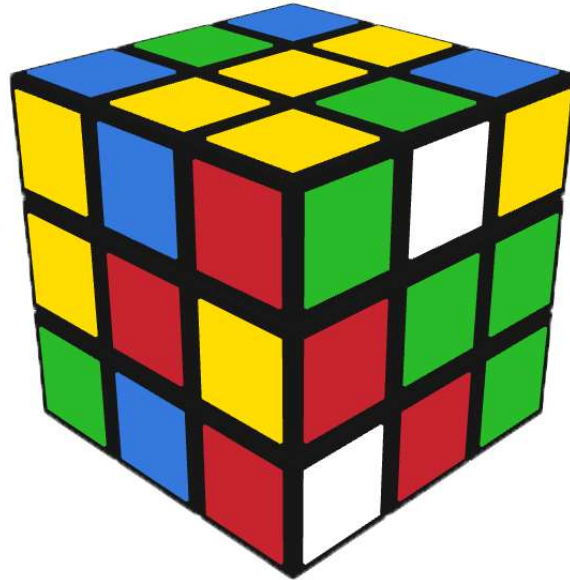


Rubik's Cube
