Allchurches Trust's Roof Protection Scheme provides grants to help churches install roof alarms in response to the issue of metal theft

As well as extending the scheme until the end of 2020, Allchurches Trust has increased the amount of funding available, with grants now funding up to 50% of the cost of an insurer-approved alarm, up to a maximum of £2500. You can still apply for a roof alarm grant, even if you have received a grant from Allchurches Trust for a different project in the last two years, and applications are normally approved within three months.
