Titchfield News, TITCHFIELD

This village publication is always a thoughtful collation of interesting articles from church and community contributors. A must-read if you want to know what's on in St Peter's and in Titchfield.

Bembridge Parish News, BEMBRIDGE

A lively A5 magazine that has benefitted from the recent inclusion of colour photos regularly.

The Hambledonian, HAMBLEDON

It's a proper village magazine, with a real emphasis on people, and includes every snippet of village news you could ever want to know. It's really well designed too, by professional graphic designer Matt Lockwood (pictured)

Bedhampton Parish, BEDHAMPTON

Printed on luxuriously thick card and paper, this A5-sized magazine includes colour photos, showcasing this church's exciting activities.

This glossy A4 publication won a diocesan award several years ago because it was distributed free of charge to all 3,600 households in the parish. It continues to spread the word effectively about St Mary's Church in the neighbourhood.
