Offering refreshments is an integral part of our church's welcome. Which churches offer the best hot drinks and snacks on a Sunday?

1 ST JOHN'S, WEST MEON

Attend Sunday worship at St John's, West Meon, and there'll be homemade cake or biscuits available after the service



2 ST MICHAEL'S, SHALFLEET

It's all very civilised at St Michael's, Shalfleet, where you're served a glass of sherry and hot sausage rolls after their BCP Mattins or Communion

3 CHRIST CHURCH PORTSDOWN

They built a special catering area inside the nave of Christ Church, making it easy to get your filter coffee - it's on offer before the service starts

4 CHURCH OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD, CROOKHORN

As well as offering breakfast to those waiting at the bus stop outside the church during the week, this church also offers homemade cakes on a Sunday morning, thanks to their fab bakers



5 HARBOUR CHURCH

Proper coffee and pastries are available before the main Sunday service at St George's Church, Portsea. Occasionally there might be smoothies or shakes instead



6 ST PETER'S, SHORWELL

Worshippers here enjoy the hospitality of the pub across the road after Sunday morning services, as often as they can organise it

7 ST JUDE'S, SOUTHSEA

They've been offering proper coffee here for more than 30 years. But come on an 'all-in' family service day for doughnuts or similar treats



8 CHRIST CHURCH, GOSPORT

There's often a feast at this church, with barista-style coffee made to order, plus fresh fruit to sample ahead of the main family service each Sunday morning

9 HOLY TRINITY, BEMBRIDGE

There's proper coffee with chocolate biscuits and cake available for those who come to Sunday worship at Holy Trinity

10 HOLY ROOD, STUBBINGTON

Yes, it's proper filter coffee on offer. But ingeniously, they offer it from two different places to make sure you don't have to queue too long
