We'll focus on the Lord's Prayer during Thy Kingdom Come 2025. Join us as we pray each day from Ascension Day to Pentecost

OUR FATHER...

This Prayer Journal takes you through the Lord's Prayer over these 10 days. On Day 1: we dare to call God 'Father' because he has invited us to be in relationship with him. As we start to pray for five people we know to become disciples, let's ask for them to know God as Father too

THY WILL BE DONE

Our yearning is for society to be ordered on earth as it is already in heaven. It's a longing for submission to God's loving plan. We can recall this on Day 4, as we meet for worship on Sunday 1 June.

FORGIVE US OUR SINS

On Day 6 - which is June 3 our Prayer Pilgrimage is around Fareham deanery. And our theme is around repentance and the forgiveness that Jesus offers. Pray that our five friends can wipe their slates clean in this way.



LEAD US NOT INTO **TEMPTATION**

Day 8 involves a Prayer Pilgrimage in Petersfield deanery. We'll recall that temptation is inevitable, and pray that our five friends can resist it as they seek a Saviour.



DELIVER US FROM EVIL



Jesus-centred, Kingdom-seeking

HALLOWED BE THY NAME

The theme for Day 2 is God's holiness. We can pray to make the praise of God the centre of our lives - and integral to the lives of those who we love.

THY KINGDOM COME

On Day 3, we envisage God's Kingdom, where his justice reigns on earth, as it does in heaven. We can pray for that hope to be real for our five friends.

GIVE US TODAY OUR DAILY BREAD

On Day 5 (June 2), the first of our Prayer Pilgrimages begins. The Rev Andrew Hargreaves (pictured *left*) will lead walkers around Bishop's Waltham deanery. praying as they go, as well as at an evening service. And it's on this day that we'll recall God's daily provision for us.

AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO SIN AGAINST US

On Day 7 we recall that forgiving others actually helps to release us from bitterness and hatred. And on this day, our Prayer Pilgrimage takes us right across Havant deanery in prayer.

FOR THINE IS THE **KINGDOM...** AMEN

Day 10 (June 7) brings our Prayer Pilgrimage to Gosport. The theme is God's kingdom, power and glory, which we pray would be reflected in our own lives



COME HOLY SPIRIT

Day 11 is Pentecost Sunday, when we recall the Holy Spirit coming in power on the disciples. But it wasn't just a gift for them the Holy Spirit filled them up and sent them outwards. It also lifts our horizons from our local churches to reach those who don't yet have faith. And on this Pentecost Sunday, our prayer pilgrimage takes us around the entire Portsea Island, with a final celebration service in our cathedral from 7.15pm. Worship is led by Harbour Church.
