ARISH GIVING SCHEME

PARISH GIVING SCHEME

> Promote regular giving by standing order/ direct debit, such as the Parish Giving Scheme and say why it's important



ANNUAL REVIEW People's salaries often increase each year. Ask them to build in a review of their personal giving each year too

DISCIPLESHIP Teaching from the pulpit and in small groups can emphasise that Christian discipleship involves living a generous life and has an impact on the wallet

thanked at least once a year for their giving - via a Christmas card, a thank-you letter, or some other way of making it

THE BUILDING

Encourage giving to your church as a way of maintaining the building for future generations

VARIETY

Encourage Christian giving in a variety of different ways and using different methods, to make it easy and convenient for people to give to your church

DIGITAL GIVING

Investigate ways that people can give digitally - perhaps with a contactless card reader, via a link



on your website, a QR code displayed on a poster or leaflet, or via a phone

LEGACIES

Provide information about why legacies are important, and don't be afraid to communicate this to congregation members

CASE STUDIES

People tend to give when they know what the money might be spent on, so give examples that resemble a shopping list, such as: £5 a week helps support our Messy Church and £15 a week will help repair our church roof
