Cornerstone has been developed by the National Giving Team, with the aim that it will take you on a journey to understand your church's giving culture and financial situation. This will leave you with clear, simple steps to grow giving and income.



Benefits of Cornerstone

As part of the Cornerstone process, you are encouraged to ask questions of yourselves and your situation.

From here, we will help you to identify areas of giving practice that could be improved; these are chosen to meet the needs of your church or parish. You are then guided through simple steps to take appropriate action on these areas.

These steps, are contained in Pathways, which are chosen by you to build on the great work you already do.

One of the main benefits of Cornerstone is that each Pathway has been designed as a series of short tasks, so that it doesn't feel too much of a burden. The aim is to make this as easy as possible while delivering great results. Some of the Pathways also provide guidance on areas that churches find challenging to work on such as 'Measuring and communicating the impact of giving' and 'Encouraging giving from new congregation members'.

Other benefits include:

- Dedicated time to review giving and generosity.
- Opportunity to complete Pathways which give the biggest impact for your specific church.
- A greater understanding for all church decision makers of church finances.
- Time saved on researching how to grow giving and generosity.
- Step by step guidance on how to develop less tangible areas of giving and generosity.
- Access to a free grants database with over 600 grant opportunities available.
- Access to your parish data which is visualised in easy to read graphs.

The Six Stages What's involved?

We have summarised the Cornerstone process into six easy to follow stages.

 Invitation - You are invited to participate in the Cornerstone process by your Diocesan Giving Advisor.

2. <u>Briefing</u> - During a webinar you are briefed on what's involved and what the expectations are.

3. <u>Research</u> - You will gather the parish's data and other information.

> 4. <u>Workshops</u> - Face to face sessions take place, examining the data that was gathered during the 'research' stage.

5. <u>Pathways</u> - You will choose actions/Pathways that will make the greatest impact on giving in your parish.

> 6. <u>Implementation</u> - You will work through your chosen Pathways.
