- **Workshop choices for children include:**

- junk modelling;
- icing animal biscuits;
- learning a "One World" song to perform (school-age children only).

Children can attend more than one workshop.

- **Workshop choices for adults and teens include:**

- how to make eco-bricks from plastic bottles and soft plastic wrapping;
- knitting with sustainable yarn;
- up-cycling (photo frames);
- making re-usable beeswax wraps for food, and reusable household wipes;
- how to live with less plastic (seminar-style session).

Workshops will be active, practical sessions. You may try more than one.
