Seminars

Delegates can choose one seminar in the morning, and another in the afternoon from the following list:

1. **Encounter Prayer – a different approach to prayer ministry:** Building on his earlier talk, John Ryeland will explore how we can help others to have a personal encounter with God that opens the door for them to meet with Jesus the healer.

2. **Healing Church Wounds:** all churches experience occasional internal conflicts which are normally worked through, however some issues are not so easily resolved and their legacies prevent the church from engaging in its mission. Rev Dr Russ Parker is pioneering a new resource which empowers churches to take ownership of their wounds and move forward to flourish in the way God wants.

3. **Deeper Healing:** Revd Elizabeth Knifton, Chaplain of Acorn Christian Healing Foundation, Whitehill Chase and Healing Adviser for Guildford Diocese, explores healing of past hurts and emotions to discover the wholeness God intends for us in Christ.

4. **Getting Started in Prayer Ministry:** Diana Dow, Licensed Reader in Gosport Deanery and Trainer for Acorn Christian Healing Foundation, along with others with recent experience of developing a prayer ministry team, discusses how to grow a healing ministry in your parish.

5. **Christian Healing and Medicine:** Do you have concerns about the way prayer for Christian Healing and medical practice relate to one another? Dr David Pearson, retired GP and Portsmouth Diocese Healing Adviser, gives some thought-provoking perspectives on the issues involved, and addresses avoiding harm through good practice in Healing Ministry.
