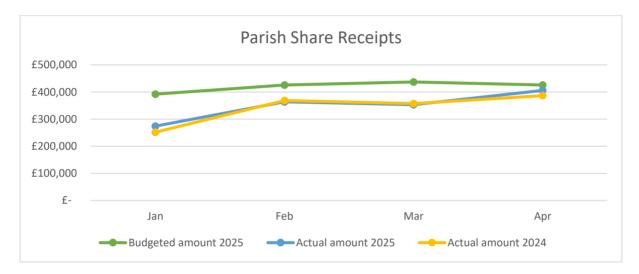




## Report on Parish Share to 30 April 2025

Details of parish share collection rates to 30 April 2025 are included in Appendix 1.

The parish share results to the end of the first quarter show the cumulative figure increasing compared to the same period in 2024. Receipts for the month of April were £405,852 compared to £386,590 in April 2024; an increase of 6.3%. Year to date receipts total £1,397,168 compared to £1,364,369 in 2024; an increase of 2.4%. This compares to an increase of 3% to the overall parish share budget and reflects an improvement from the position reported in March which was 1.4 uplift compared to the previous year.



The position with regards payment from individual parishes against 2025 share is as follows (broken down by deanery):

There has been a significant improvement in the number of parishes who have not yet contributed to share since last month (21). We continue to seek explanations for the remaining parishes. Some have historically paid in full towards the end of the year.





At the end of April, we are reporting 48.8% of parishes who are on or ahead of target. This has fallen slightly since last month when we reported this figure at 51.2%, however this is expected as some parishes pay quarterly and would therefore have been up to date at the end of March, with the next payment not anticipated until June. In April 2024, we reported 46.1% of parishes in this position and so we continue to show an improving trend.

We have now met with all parishes who have requested a discussion around their parish share. These conversations have in some instances led to some small reductions to parish share allocations, whilst others have helped to raise awareness of concerns for future years. This has also enabled us to identify areas where additional support may be provided, for example with implementation of contactless giving devices, or signposting to available grants.

We will now look to present the parish share figures by deanery on the website and hope to have this complete by mid-May.

Of the total parish share budget of £5,379k, we currently have 89.3% allocated to individual parishes and therefore at this early stage are on target to meet the minimum 88% collection rate outlined in the budget scenario. For some parishes where a smaller sum has been agreed following a conversation, they have also noted that if they are able to meet the original slightly higher request, they will. This might allow some of the remaining 10.7% to also be recovered.

Monthly reviews continue to be held with the Diocesan Secretary, Stewardship Advisor and Head of Finance to monitor collection rates for individual parishes and follow up with those behind with payments to better understand the reasons for this and inform planning and forecasting.
