#### **Foundation Governor Forms**

For maintained schools, the <u>Foundation Governor Nomination Appointment Form</u> and <u>Reappointment Form</u> have now been updated and are available on the <u>Diocese website</u>. Please ensure that the new forms are now used for all appointments as they contain the extra information that is now required.

For schools that are part of our Portsmouth and Winchester Diocesan Academies Trust, the <u>Appointment Form</u> for Local Governing Boards Foundation or Co-opted Governors can be found on the <u>P&WDAT</u> Website under resources.

For academy governors from other academies, please use the Academy Foundation Governor Nomination Form and Re-appointment Form. This will be added to the website soon. If you need one of these forms, please contact Sharon or Amanda.

Please note that for new Foundation Governor appointments, we require the DBS certificate number and date. We are unable to approve the forms until we have this information which is why you will find there is often a delay between sending the form to us and the appointment being made. For re-appointments we also require the DBS number and date to be added to the form. Please also remember to get all the signatures that are required on the form including that of the Parish.

#### **Thinking Governance**

The Church of England have a website called '<u>Thinking Governance'</u> dedicated to Governance. It aims to help governors with the issues that they may face when working with a Church of England school or academy. It also provides 4 training <u>modules</u> which governors can complete free of charge.

#### What the Diocesan Office needs to know

I have been asked by several clerks what information they should be providing the Diocesan Office with. For all maintained schools and academies, It is important that we are informed of the following:

- <u>New Foundation Governors</u> The appointment forms need to be sent to us for approval.
- <u>Re-appointment of Foundation Governors</u> When their term of office comes to an end, if the Foundation Governor is to be reappointed, then please complete the reappointment form and send this into us. If they have decided not to continue, please email us so that we can end the term and send them a thank you letter.
- <u>Foundation Governors who resign</u> If a governor resigns before the end of their term, then please email us with the name of the governor and the date that they finished. Again this allows us to update our system and to send a thank you letter.
- <u>New Clerk</u> If the clerk changes, please let us have the name and new contact details of the clerk. We often contact clerks to check administrative information and for copies of documents, so it is imperative that we hold the correct information.
- <u>Chair of Governors</u> The Chair is not always a Foundation Governor. It is useful if we know the name and email address of the chair in case we need to contact them regarding the school and also so that they receive any key updates and information that we may send out. If the Chair is a Foundation Governor, again, let us know and we can add this to their record.

For Academies, we also require details of the <u>Members, Directors</u> and <u>Company Secretary</u> of the Trust. (This applies to Multi Academy Trusts, Single Academy Trusts and Umbrella Trusts.) We must be informed of any changes to this information in the same way as being informed of any changes to your Local Governing Board.

A copy of you Admissions policy must be sent to the Education Team at the Diocesan Office once finalised.



A guide has been produced outlining <u>Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch up Premium</u> allocations for 2017-2018 and how this money can be used.


# Online Safety in Schools : Questions from the Governing Board

#### What Maintained Schools Must Publish online

Can I remind Governors that it is important that you ensure that your school is complying with the information that it must publish online. Every Local Authority Maintained School must publish specific information on its website in order to comply with the 'School Information (England) (Amendment) Regulation 2016'

If you are unsure what should be available then please look at the <u>DfE Guidance</u>.

If you are an Academy, then please read the Guidance on <u>What Academies Must Publish</u> Online.

The Diocese will be checking School websites randomly to check that they comply with the statutory guidance.

Please also remember that a Governing Board has a duty to ensure that they make available all agendas, approved minute and papers of its meetings and committees with delegated powers.
