Questions a Governing Board should ask themselves

- 1) What sort of involvement does the governing board have in the schools self-evaluation?
- 2) Can you tell me the three main strengths of the school?
- 3) What are the schools three main areas of improvement?
- 4) What is the impact of additional funding i) Pupil Premium funding for disadvantaged pupils, ii) year 7 catch up funding, iii) PE and sports funding/?

 How much does the school receive? What has the impact of the funding been? What difference has it made/ (For all year groups.)
- 5) Is your school website compliant? (This will be looked at during an Ofsted pre inspection phase.) Is your Governor area of the website up to date?
- 6) How much training has the governing board received? What impact has this had?
- 7) How good is personal development, behaviour and welfare of pupils in the school? How do you know this?
- 8) What is the attendance and persistence absence like at the school? If below average, what is in place to improve this?
- 9) How are bullying and racist incidents dealt with? How many are there in the school?
- 10) If there has been an external review of governance, what changes or improvements has this brought about.
