

# Embedding Understanding Christianity:

## Salvation and Kingdom of God



Following the introduction of the “Understanding Christianity” resource, this training day will support RE teachers in delivering UC in the classroom, focussing on the following Christian concepts: **Salvation** and **Kingdom of God**. We will explore a range of teaching and learning strategies and look at practical ways to plan and teach these concepts. For Hampshire schools, this will include linking the resources to the Cycle of Enquiry in Living Difference 111.

The intended outcomes are:

Increased confidence in teaching about Christianity in RE.

Familiarisation with a range of teaching and learning strategies to enable effective learning in RE and to help pupils become more theologically literate.

**To gain maximum benefit from this session, someone from your school should have completed the initial Understanding Christianity training. It would be helpful to bring your Understanding Christianity folder and a laptop with you to the training day.**
