Make together.....

Easter gardens often have:

A tomb with a stone rolled away A hill with 3 crosses on A pathway to the cross A white cloth People – Jesus, the disciples, the women who found the empty tomb, soldiers Trees and grass Flowers

What will you put in your Easter garden?

Play together.....

You will need: some lively music!

Lie down very quiet and still like Jesus would have in the tomb.

When the music starts, jump up and dance around – imagine how excited Jesus's friends were when they heard he was alive!

When the music stops again, lie back down quiet and still.

Keep playing until you get tired or you get to the end of the song!

Pray together.....

See if you can lie very still while an adult says these words, then jump up at the end like Jesus coming back to life!

- God, we know Jesus died and it made his friends sad
- We know we make choices that sometimes are bad
- But we know that you love us and want to be friends
- And we know Jesus rose and his love never ends!
