ROLE OVERVIEW

Crofton Parish has a long history of ministry to children and young people. We wish to appoint a committed Christian to lead our work with youth into a new season. This is an exciting leadership opportunity to develop Crofton's youth ministry, working alongside a committed team of volunteers.

With a large number of children and young people involved in the life of our church, we are looking for someone to lead this important ministry area and develop new ways for young people to find faith for themselves and within their families. The successful candidate will be able to draw upon their gifts to grow a strong community within our young people, helping them to grow as life-long disciples of Christ.

Presently, we run a range of groups for children and young people of all ages. We also have excellent relationships with the schools in our community. We are looking for someone who will nurture and care for the young people already involved in parish life and particularly, work alongside the staff team and volunteers to develop new pathways into belonging for 11-18s and their families in our community.

Please Note This is a part-time post, and all part-time applications will be considered. We are also advertising for a person to lead our children's ministry. The two roles could be combined for a candidate with a focus on either children's ministry, youth ministry or both. Such a (nearly) full-time position (32 hrs/week) could involve leading in your specialism and overseeing the other. ABOUT CROFTON PARISH

Crofton Parish serves the Hampshire coastal communities of Stubbington and Hill Head. Our vision is to be 'The Heart of God at the Heart of our Community'.

We have two church centres. Holy Rood, the Parish Church, has a well-established, multigenerational congregation of about 300. Part of the New Wine Network, we are a contemporary, charismatic, evangelical Anglican church. St Edmund's has a more traditional approach and offers a place of worship and prayer to a mainly older congregation.

Holy Rood has been a centre of Youth and Children's ministry for many years, both within our congregation and community. The vision for this ministry area is to help young people take their place as the church of today and tomorrow. High quality youth work is a key part of what we offer our community: safe, supportive environments for families and young people to belong and, if they wish, explore the Christian faith for themselves.

The successful candidate will be a key member of our staff team, playing a vital role in the growth and development of an area of ministry and mission that is right at the heart of our Parish life.

As the successful candidate for this post, we are looking for an individual who:

- has a deep Christian faith, which overflows into a passion for next generation ministry;
- is a person of integrity, able to operate within clear boundaries and modelling these for the next generation;
- has a good understanding of the distinct needs of different age groups and a vision for both outreach and discipleship;
- is a good communicator, able to communicate the message of the gospel in applicable, relevant ways, and be confident leading upfront in groups and services;
- will identify opportunities to innovate best practice in Youth Ministry;
- wants to work as a key member of an enthusiastic staff team committed to collaborative ministry;
- will be a team leader, able to recruit and equip volunteers, with support from the safeguarding and administration team;
- has a secure understanding of the need for fostering a good safeguarding culture and their roles and responsibilities within this.

- Development of community outreach, including work with local schools where we already have well-established relationships;
- Working with the whole team to identify and support young people's pastoral needs;
- Communication & administration necessary to deliver the above (some admin support will be available from our Parish Admin team), including digital/social media;
- Awareness of, and compliance with, any legislation appropriate to Crofton Parish, such as Safeguarding, Health & Safety and Data Protection.
